# UNPACKING

First check and identify the contents of your D/A Converter package, as listed below:


- & Orpheus Heritage D/A CONVERTER PSU (Power Supply Unit)
- & Orpheus Heritage D/A CONVERTER APU (Audio Processing Unit)
- 2 inter unit power cords (PSR and PSL)
- ☆ 1 inter unit command cord (CMD)
- & User manual CD-ROM (included Drivers PC / MAC)
- & Certification

### **READ THIS BEFORE OPERATING YOUR UNIT**

- & Please read this manual carefully, to assure proper operation and the possible performance.
- & Switch off the unit before connecting or disconnecting any input or output cables.
- Do not touch the inner pins of rear panel connectors, electrostatic discharge may cause permanent damage to the unit.
- Choose the installation location for the unit carefully. Avoid placing it in direct sunlight or close to a source of heat. Avoid also locations subject to vibration and excessive dust, heat, cold or moisture.
- & To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose the unit to rain or moisture.
- & Do not use force when operating switches, knobs and other controls.
- Do not open the chassis or attempt repairs by yourself, as this may result in damage to the unit or electrical shock. If a foreign object should get into the unit, contact your local dealer.
- & When planning not to use the unit for a long period of time, it is advisable to disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet.
- & To prevent lightning damage, disconnect the power plug when there is an electrical storm.
- & When moving the unit, be sure to first disconnect the power plug and all wires connected from the unit to other equipment.
- & When disconnecting the power plug from the wall outlet, always pull directly on the plug, never pill the cord itself.
- b Do not attempt to clean this unit with water or chemical solvents, as this may damage the unit or the finish. Use a clean, dry cloth.
- & Keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.



#### User manual Heritage D/A CONVERTER III



INPUT LEFT Select the next input

### INPUT RIGHT

Selects the next input

PHASE INVERSION LED9 ON = phase inverted / LED9 OFF = no phase inversion

### STANDBY

Press the PHASE INVERSION first and then press the INPUT LEFT button to place the D/A CONVERTER in standby. If the LED10 is ON, the device is in standby.

### LED BRIGHTNESS

Press the PHASE INVERSION first and then press the INPUT RIGHT button to set the brightness of the LED. You should see the intensity of the light from the LED changing.



# **QUICK GUIDE**

#### AND USB

#### POWER ON

Flip the main power switch located on the rear panel from OFF to ON. All LEDs blink for about 10 to 15 seconds. This is the time needed to stabilize all power supplies.

#### **GOING INTO STANDBY**

To activate the Standby mode, the button 3 has to be held pressed while the button 1 is pressed.

To release the Heritage DAC from standby mode, one of the three buttons has to be pressed.

During this mode, the logo and all LEDs, except LED9, are OFF.

The Heritage DAC will go in Standby mode automatically if the input is not locked or the audio signal remains at zero for about 60 min.

The whole configuration of the appliance is recorded in flash memory and thus preserved when Heritage DAC is turned OFF or in standby mode.

#### INSTALL DRIVERS FOR FIREWIRE

The drivers ASIO are provided on the CD of the User's Manual with the path: Drivers\Firewire. According the computer you have, you will have to select the correct folder in order to install the correct driver.

After having installed the drivers and after reboot, your computer is ready to work with the Firewire interface of the D/A Converter.



#### INSTALL DRIVERS FOR USB

You need only install drivers under Windows. The driver are provided on the CD of the User's Manual with the path: Drivers\USB.

#### USB - Windows / PC

Connect the DAD to your PC with a usb cable.

Turn on the machine

if this is the first time that you connect the DAD To your PC, please install the driver from the CD. The path of the drivers is: driver\USB\HDAudioSetup.exe

After few seconds, the DAD will be ready to play music.

If the sound is too low or high.

- Right-click the speaker icon in the system tray (at the far right of the Windows)
- Click Open Volume Controls.
- Drag the slider in the left column with the mouse to adjust master volume.

If the sound doesn't come :

- Right-click the speaker icon in the system tray (at the far right of the Windows)
- Check if the HD audio is selected.

#### USB - OSX / MAC

- connect the DAD to your MAC with a USB cable.
- Turn on the machine.
- Click on the icon Preference Panes (usually located on the the dock).
- Click on the loudspeaker to modify the sound settings.
- Click on the output tab.
- Click on USB Audio to choose this type of output rather than the onboard speaker of the computer.
- Your DAD is now ready to play music like an external sound card.
